God needs to open the door for our Church to stop fighting internal fights about WHO can preach and administer the Sacrament and to move toward supporting all our people in this godly endeavour to share Christ in all the ways we are called, gifted and willing to serve.

We spend a short amount of time sharing what we might pray for and what has been going on for us recently, reading Scripture, and then praying. We sometimes laugh and occasionally shed some tears. I realise the time we meet is not ideal for many or any of us but we try out best to connect with each other across multiple time zones and our diversely different schedules.
